Minutes

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The event took place in Vega Hall, in the Unirea Hotel&Spa, in lasi city central, on 27 October 2019.

The event had started with registration of participants. After all participants had take place in the meeting hall, the opening of the event, it was a small musical moment, supported by a music teacher, playing some musical moments on the lute instrument. Teacher Ovidiu Adrian Sabie, on behalf of Colegiul National de Arta "Octav Bancila" host of the event, had present a brief description of the school, and on behalf of School EuroEd, partner in OFF-BOOK project, teachers Carmen Antonita had also presented a brief description of her school.

The program continued with a ppt. presentation, done by teacher Ovidiu Adrian Sabie. He describe the context from which the project had started, the coordinators and partners involved in the OFF-BOOK project, the objectives and results of the project: I.O.1 and I.O.2., and indicated to the audience where they can you find them. YouTube Channel of the project was presented to, with some examples from each partner.

After a small coffee break, the event has continued with a workshop held by Nicolae Ionescu, where he put in practice with students 5 Tabs, inviting also the audience to take part in it. After it, we had a debate moment about how to use the tabs, what materials do teachers need, in what place it is appropriate to put in practice the exercises, time needed, and most of all what are the results that can be archived through the I.O.s

- Participants attending the multiplayer event were 77 people, from different region of the country.
- The profile of teachers involved in the event: a. Age range: 30-55; b. subjects taught: literature, arts, sciences; c. Different background regarding using of non-formal education.
- Teachers with a different background and different area of expertise and teaching experience.
- Teachers at the end of the event, were very interested in applying these activities in their classroom (needed to know how many minutes do they need to use from their usual time in class). All tabs presented and the YouTube channel, were appreciated (they can see exactly how to apply it) easy to use and understand the steps needed. These types of activities are needed, most of the teachers was looking for non-formal activities, but are very hard to find free of charge and time consuming when is presented as text (do to the time consuming). YouTube channel was the biggest success.
