Description of the Organization

Klaipeda University – is multidisciplinary national and Baltic Sea Region research and studies leader, promoter of cultural heritage, and lifelong learning centre integrated in international academic networks. Klaipeda University was established on January 1, 1991 with three faculties. Today University has five faculties: the Humanities and Education, Marine and Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, and Health Sciences, and Academy of Arts; it also has a study institute (Continuing Studies Intitute) and a research institute (Institute of Baltic Sea Region History and Archaeology). Rapidly developing University today is home for over 4500 students. There are 118 three-cycle study programs providing the student with research-based modern knowledge and technological based on higher university education level and higher

education qualification, develops fully educated research projects, has the scientific and academic partners in Europe and elsewhere in the world, and is also involved in a dozen international funds, programs and networks.

Socio-economic circumstances formed rapid development needs for Klaipeda University.
